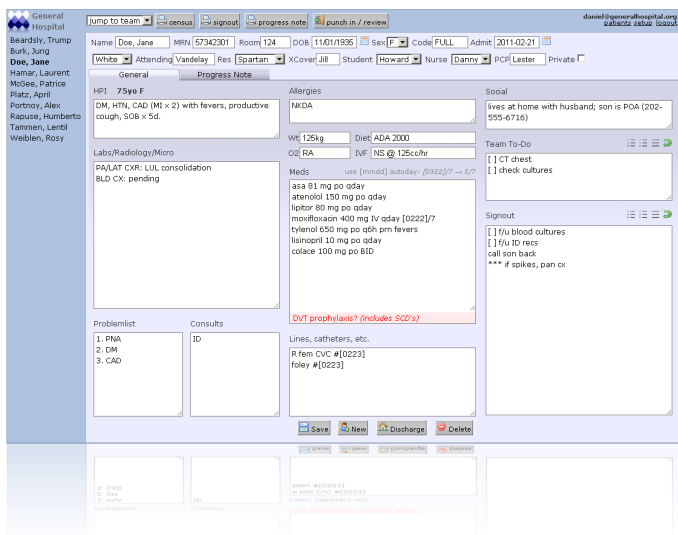




Fact: 2011 ACGME regulations will further limit duty hours, meaning more transitions of care, and more opportunities for confusion and medical errors.

Solution: WardManager is an online signout tool that provides a structured and team-based signout customized to meet your program's needs, reduce medical errors, and save time.

Print-outs: From the single customized dashboard (pictured below), WardManager automatically prints individual and team signouts, census/rounding reports, and optional progress notes.



Timeline: We guarantee to have you up and running in one week or your first month is free.

Services: Full customization, hourly backup, HIPAA compliance, and 24/7 support.

Cost: WardManager is a monthly subscription service based on average patient volume, starting at \$500 for unlimited accounts and teams. We have no cancellation fees, and if you sign up before July 1, 2011, the setup and the first month are free.

Frequently Asked Questions

“Can we customize WardManager?”

Yes. Our forms and print-outs are 100% customizable to meet the specific needs of your specialty and program.

“Can we access WardManager from anywhere?”

Yes. WardManager is accessible from any computer or handheld device (e.g. iPad) with internet access.

“What else does WardManager do for us?”

WardManager tracks antibiotic and central line/foley days, provides reminders (e.g. DVT prophylaxis), and simplifies re-admissions by remembering discharged patients. Optional features include integrated progress notes and duty hour tracking.

“We already have or are getting an EMR soon. Can we still use WardManager? Can it integrate with our EMR?”

Yes. Most of our academic partners have EMRs but are not satisfied with the way their EMRs handle signout. WardManager can be used as an independent signout system and can also integrate with and complement your EMR.

“How does WardManager handle team transitions?”

WardManager is structured around a team of providers and mirrors your hospital workflow. Patient information is shared amongst all team members, and when providers change services, all patient signout information is immediately at their fingertips. No need to rebuild lists or re-enter signout.

“Who else uses WardManager?”

We manage signout from coast to coast, in public and private institutions, both large and small. Our clients include numerous residency programs, as well as hospitalist groups. Among the specialties using WardManager are Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, Family Medicine, Surgery, Neurology, Critical Care and Gastroenterology.

“How do academic programs justify the cost?”

Transitions of care are a critical patient safety issue and risk management liability.
